ORDER OF PLAY: Tee times starting at 7:30 am Saturday / 8:30 am Sunday
27 Holes Saturday and 18 Holes on Sunday.
Order of flights will be determined by random draw

FORMAT: Nine-hole best ball match play.

Entry includes a BBQ on Saturday by Fairways & Greens.
Breakfast sandwiches will be available for purchase.

REGISTRATION: All CCB Member/Member teams or CCB Member/ 1-Guest may register now.
Half payment is due at registration.

Guest/Guest teams may register after May 10th

Guests will be charged an additional \$75 per player to cover greens fees.

All players must have a WHS/GHIN Handicap Index to compete in this tournament.

(Junior members may play with an adult member 21 or older)

Tournament size increases in groups of 6. Starting at 42 teams, additional teams will be waitlisted until a new flight can be created. Maximum field size is 54 teams.

Flight info

6, two-person teams per flight

Blue White Gold* Red**

Strokes @ 100% for the tees you play

Players with + handicap will be assessed a handicap of 0

*If there are 6 gold tee teams, there will be a gold flight. If there are more than 6 teams, the lowest handicapped team will be moved to the white flight. If there are less than 6 teams, mixed gold/white teams will be permitted and strokes will be assessed based on the tees you are playing.

**If there are 6 red tee teams, there will be a red flight. There will not be a mixed red/white flight if there are not enough teams to create a red tee flight.

No handicap restrictions for players to partner up. However, partner handicaps with a difference of more than 10 will have an adjustment made (10 stroke rule) –

e.g. if a 6 handicap and 22 handicap team up the 22 handicapper will play at a 16 handicap

Flights are determined by combined partner handicaps after adjustments for tee and partner rule are made.
